I've been told before that to truly learn a language you should learn its idioms, so this book stood out. It was a perfect choice. The format is great for my kindle, and the phrases are inserted in a way that makes it easy to learn. The recommendation is for one phrase a day, and the book is divided in a way that makes it easy to spend a whole year learning these phrases. I, however, will have a hard time sticking to that rule, because the phrases used are both useful and interesting. The author has put both the actual meaning, as well as the direct translation together, which kept me wanted to go forward to learn more and more, as it was very cool to see the difference. For example, we learn that the meaning of to faint, when directly

translated is "to fall in the apples." I truly don't believe I would have learned many of these phrases without this book, and am excited to use them when I do make my trip this next summer. I would highly recommend this book to anyone looking to travel to a french speaking country, or to anyone who has an interest in the language. It is well-organized and interesting.

Straight forward and direct, it does not bother with explanations that tend to overwhelm new learners, and annoy the more advance learners. Instead it provides the bare basic, this is what you want to say? Then this is how you say it. It also only focuses on French, not on Canadian French. The book is more for a person who already has background in French, however. Though I do believe it can help new learners as well, just they will need to put in their own effort with the finer details. Luckily, there is an MP3 option, which I think would help the newer learners with pronunciation. Giving it five stars, as it has helped me greatly, and I believe it can help learners from stages new to advance.

365 Days of French Expressions is a great introduction to French. The author identifies the French idiom, what the meaning of it is, and what it would literally translate to in English. No wonder the translation websites are so ineffective when it comes to languages like French and Spanish. The book's layout provides readers with 365 of these idioms. At the start of each week there is a weekly recap which tests readers' knowledge of what they learned the week before. While some of the expressions/idioms are a bit outlandish and bizarre, the book provides some good fundamental phrases which would be of immense help to anyone travelling to a French speaking country.

I am a fan of language, but have always had a hard time learning a new language. I saw this book and thought it would be cool to learn some French idioms. Maybe lâ [™]II learn something and be able to take it a step further. The book is set up in weekly doses. Each day is a new idiom written in French, the explanation in English along with the literal translation (what each word actually means). I think you can learn a lot through this method. You can learn the idiom and the meaning of each individual word. At the end of the week is a recap asking for the translation of two idioms. I like for every idiom there is an example of its use in a sentence. Real world application. I really like that the audio version is included. Being able to pronounce the words correctly is very important when it comes to learning a language. The speaker has a nice strong male French accent. Listening and reading this book is not something you can just do one time. I think you need to go over it multiple times to understand how heâ [™]s pronouncing each word, how they flow into a sentence. This book is good for the new French language learner as well as more advanced speakers. Itâ [™]s not just good to be able literally translate words but knowing how they are applied really helps.
